Practically all major funders require the inclusion of Open Science concepts in research. Most prominently among these requirements are open access publications and publication of research data according to the FAIR data principles, requiring proper research data management. This lecture provides a short overview about the many dimensions of Open Science and related key concepts of research data management using examples from the Earth System Sciences. It highlights how researchers can benefit from this cultural change and presents simple yet powerful steps for the inclusion and promotion of Open Science in everyday research practices.
